The Trustees of the Village Hall feel that from time to time it would be useful to update our regular hirers by way of a newsletter, and we hope you will appreciate this approach. The trustees would like to thank our regular hirers for their continued support.

Regular Hirer Fees, The Trustees are happy to announce that there will be no increase this year. We have increased the hire cost for a children's party as it had not changed in 10 years but this will have no effect on the groups that regularly hire the Hall.

Hall Improvements

Due to a generous donation from Better Brew we have now installed a projector which will enable hirers to link their laptops, tablets and phones to project images and video on to the motorized screen above the stage. It will also link into the audio system. Hirers will also be able to use the projector and screen on request. (We don't want to lose the remote control by leaving it out!).

Community Cinema

Items stored on the Premises

We have updated clause 16 of our Conditions of Hire to clarify that if hirers leave items stored on the premises for their regular weekly or monthly meetings it is at their own risk and not covered by our insurance. The hall is insured for public liability, buildings all risk and contents owned by the Hall.

We plan to contact those groups known to have equipment stored merely to clarify what that equipment is and also to remind them that it will not be covered by our insurance. It would be useful if those groups could email our Treasurer Tony Stafford tony.stafford2@icloud.com and advise him what is stored and confirm they are aware that the Hall's insurance will not cover it.
